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Statement for Publication

Accent Language School in Guernsey is run by an energetic and committed Director and a small, loyal staff team. It operates in large premises in a good, central location. Although occupying a large floor area, the layout of rooms creates some constraints for the school's operation, which it does well to manage effectively. The premises at Elizabeth College are appropriate for Accent's summer courses and offer the school the potential to expand.

The school has succeeded in maintaining the ABLS standard since accreditation was awarded in 2017. Its general organisation, management, administration and academic management are satisfactory. The school is urged to make full use of the Academic Manager's expertise to improve the standard of teaching across the school. Welfare policies and procedures, particularly in relation to the care of juniors, are good.
