Statement for Publication

ELC has moved into its current premises which better suit the number of courses it runs and students it enrolls. The premises are in an easily accessible area of town and are of a good standard. The lack of break-out space and a teachers' room are disadvantages and the premises would be cramped when at full capacity. The school will need to see how the available space serves it over the busy period in the summer.

The school has managed to transfer its operation to the new site over the Christmas holiday period without disrupting its programme of courses. Teachers and the administrator have also transferred to the new site and have provided reassuring continuity for students.
